

SAFEGUARDING LEVEL 1 – INDUCTION

This 60-minute induction is for all those working or volunteering (paid or unpaid church worker) in the Archdiocese. It introduces the Safeguarding Policy and Guidelines, types of abuse (physical, emotional, sexual and neglect), the Code of Conduct and the importance of safeguarding in church roles.

Online sessions use ZOOM video conferencing. You will need an internet connection, a computer, smartphone or tablet with speakers, a microphone and a webcam either built-in or attached to your device. If you are unable to access IT, please visit your Parish/Agency/Organisation office to arrange the use of facilities.


Our Lady of Grace School Tours - TERM 2
