The Day of Pentecost

Today we celebrate the great day of Pentecost when Christ filled the Church with the power of his Spirit and sent it out into the world to bring his peace, joy and forgiveness to all mankind.

FIRST READING

A reading from the Acts of the Apostles
Acts of the Apostles 2:1-11



When Pentecost day came round, the apostles had all met in one room, when suddenly they heard what sounded like a powerful wind from heaven, the noise of which filled the entire house in which they were sitting; and something appeared to them that seemed like tongues of fire; these separated and came to rest on the head of each of them. They were filled with the Holy Spirit, and began to speak foreign languages as the Spirit gave them the gift of speech. Now there were devout men living in Jerusalem from every nation under heaven, and at this sound they all assembled, each one bewildered to hear these men speaking his own language. They were amazed and astonished. 'Surely' they said 'all these men speaking are Galileans? How does it happen that each of us hears them in his own native language? Parthians, Medes and Elamites; people from Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya round Cyrene; as well as visitors from Rome - Jews and proselytes alike - Cretans and Arabs; we hear them preaching in our own language about the marvels of God.'

SECOND READING

A reading from the letter of St Paul to the Galatians
Galatians 5:16-25

If you are guided by the Spirit you will be in no danger of yielding to self-indulgence, since self-indulgence is the opposite of the Spirit, the Spirit is totally against such a thing, and it is precisely because the two are so opposed that you do not always carry out your good intentions. If you are led by the Spirit, no law can touch you. When self-indulgence is at work the results are obvious: fornication, gross indecency and sexual irresponsibility; idolatry and sorcery; feuds and wrangling, jealousy, bad temper and quarrels; disagreements, factions, envy; drunkenness, orgies and similar things. I warn you now, as I warned you before: those who behave like this will not inherit the kingdom of God. What the Spirit brings is very different: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, trustfulness, gentleness and self-control. There can be no law against things like that, of course. You cannot belong to Christ Jesus unless you crucify all self-indulgent passions and desire.

Since the Spirit is our life, let us be directed by the Spirit.

PARISH NOTES

Parish Pastoral Council

The Parish Pastoral Council met on Thursday night 2nd May 2024 at 7pm.

- Fathers Report: Holy Week and Easter Service were well attended and thank you to all who assisted throughout.
- Sacramental Program: Children to be confirmed on 18th and 19th May. Training of altar servers continues.

Anzac Day Mass was well attended followed by a morning tea in the Parish Centre. Parishioners service medals were on display and the Anzac biscuits were made by year 2 OLG Students.

• Safeguarding Training Level 1 Induction. It was discussed that this training was to be completed by ALL parish Church workers both paid and unpaid.

The times for this training have been set out in the Credo and on the Parish website.

A Statutory declaration form must then be completed when the level 1 training has been undertaken. This form is to be handed into the parish office.

These forms are available from the parish office or from any Safeguarding officer. We are expecting to be audited on all levels of Safeguarding by the Archdiocese within the coming months.

- Mark Fuderer reported that the finance committee are currently preparing the 2025 Budget and it will be presented to the PPC at the end of May for formal adoption.
- The PPC expressed great concern on the time delays for the renovation of the Presbytery. No written building contract has been received. It needs to be dealt with urgently.
- Regular cleaning arrangements for the Parish Centre are under review and the PPC is looking at options for cleaning twice a week.
- Maintenance Committee has a number of small ongoing projects. Anyone interested and able to assist please contact Jim Joseph.

SAFEGUARDING LEVEL 1 – INDUCTION

This 60-minute induction is for all those working or volunteering (paid or unpaid church worker) in the Archdiocese. It introduces the Safeguarding Policy and Guidelines, types of abuse (physical, emotional, sexual and neglect), the Code of Conduct and the importance of safeguarding in church roles. Online sessions use ZOOM video conferencing. You will need an internet connection, a computer, smartphone or tablet with speakers, a microphone and a webcam either built-in or attached to your device. If you are unable to access IT, please visit your Parish/Agency/Organisation office to arrange the use of facilities.
